

ECLIPSES.

There will be Two Eclipses visible this Year at QUEBEC.

VIZ. ONE OF THE SUN, AND ONE OF THE MOON.

The first Eclipse will be of the Sun on the 3d of April; 9 Digits 25 minutes on the Southern part of the Sun: Will begin 16 minutes after 6 o'Clock in the morning; its middle will be 25 minutes after 7 and will end 43 minutes after 8.

The second Eclipse will be of the Moon, on the 12th of October, 9 Digits $3\frac{1}{2}$ minutes on the North part of the Moon: Will begin 12 minutes after 7 o'Clock in the evening, its middle will be 47 minutes after 8 and will end 19 minutes after 10.

Explanation of the Calendar.

The first column contains the days of the month, the second the days of the week, and the third the Holidays, &c. and the 4th the rising and setting of the Sun.
