For a third time since the outbreak of the great war has come to the home of Mr. and Mrs. J. W. McIntosh of New Glasgow, the terrible news that a son has been killed in battle. Five sons of this family entered the national service. A year ago Alfred McIntosh was called upon to make the supreme sacrifice; a few weeks ago the fateful message came that Herbert McIntosh had been killed, and now Mrs. McIntosh has received the third message that William Hayward McIntosh had given his young life in defence of the empire. The two other boys of this family who enlisted are overseas, Murray being on the Irish line and Stewart training in England.

RETIREMENT OF MAJOR-GENERAL HODGINS COMING

Partial Re-organization of Militia Headquarters Staff at Ottawa

Montreal, Sept. 5.—A despatch to the Gazette says that Major-General Hodgins, adjutant-general of the Canadian militia, will soon retire from active service and his retirement will be followed by a partial re-organization of the militia headquarters staff.

It is understood that either Major-General C. J. MacDougall or Major-General S. Mewburn will succeed General Hodgins as adjutant-general.

U. S. SENATE MOVEMENT TO CONSCRIPT WEALTH TO PAY WAR BILLS FAILS

Washington, Sept. 5.—The movement in the senate to conscript wealth to pay the United States war bill suffered a final and decisive defeat yesterday. The Hollis amendment restoring the pre-war basis for computing war profits taxes; the La Follette sixty per cent war profits tax amendment; and the Hollis fifty per cent war profits amendment were all voted down by the senate in rapid succession by overwhelming majorities.
