**CUT IN WAGES IN LUMBER WOODS** (Fredericton, N.S.)  
Wages in the lumber woods in this vicinity have taken quite a sharp cut this past week, and it is said that a further cut may come after the first of January. The prevailing rate of wages at the present time is \$40 per month and board, whereas last season \$75 per month was paid. In one camp on the St. John river a crew of men who were working for \$60 a month lately made a demand on their employer for \$80, but he was unable to see his way clear to grant their request. As a result fifteen of the men quit work, claiming that they could do better elsewhere. The prevailing rate, however, is in the vicinity of \$40, which amounts to \$230 per day and board. Lumbermen say that they can get all the men they want at this figure and the unstable condition of the lumber market will not allow them to pay any more. Lumber operators declare that the chances of pulling out ahead this season in the lumbering game are not very bright, and that they are merely operating a few camps for the purpose of keeping up their organization. It is said that in the Maine woods at the present time the wages being paid to lumbermen range from \$30 to \$40 a month and board.

**SAYS FARMING IS ON COMPETITIVE BASIS.**  
Toronto, Dec. 14—Howard Bertram, newly elected master of the Dominion Grange, at a banquet of the delegates to the annual meeting of the Grange in this city, last night said that if it had not been for the dominion grange there would have been no U. F. O. in this province.

**J. C. Dixon**, the retiring master of the grange in his annual address yesterday, said: "Farming is now practically the only industry on a purely competitive basis. He declared that on a competitive basis profiteering was impossible. "It brings out our best efforts," he said, "and makes the world prosper."

**GREEK DESTROYER LOST BUT THE CREW SAVED**  
Athens, Dec. 14—The Greek destroyer Navarokostas, founded in the Mediterranean, near the Island of Metos yesterday. The crew were saved.

The Navarokostas was built in 1909 and displaced 400 tons. She was 212 feet long and carried two 4-inch guns, four six pounders and two torpedo tubes. Her crew numbered fifty-eight men.
