SYNDICATE of Canadian Northwest

Land Regulations.
ANY person who is the head of a
family or who may hereafter be so, and
who has been a resident of any of the
provinces of Canada for at least one
year, and who is a Canadian citizen, or
has been a resident of the Dominion of
Ireland for at least one year, and who
is a British subject, may apply to the
Department of the Interior for a grant
of land in the Northwest Territories.

Entry by proxy may be made by a
person authorized in writing by the
applicant, on certain conditions, by father,
mother, son, daughter, brother or sister,
or any other person.

Duties—Six months residence upon and
cultivation of the land in each of three
years. A homestead may be made on a
tract of land of not less than 160 acres
and not more than 1,600 acres, and may
be of any shape, and may be situated in
any part of the Northwest Territories.

acres, and may be of any shape, and may
be situated in any part of the Northwest
Territories.
