

## Premier Makes Declaration of Impenitence

The world to give greater power to the federal campaign. I called attention to this fact many months ago, and history was a record of being so, but what I said was true and the events of the past week have proven it so absolutely true that nobody now who wanted to be believed would venture to deny the truth.

I know they are only trying to make a deal with labor to gain their own ends, and against the interests of labor and I do not believe that in this direction they can succeed very far. I know as well that thousands of their own numbers do not want an alliance with any "extremists," because farmers, who are interested in farming even more than they are interested in political power, want security of property. They are just as strongly against Communistic and Socialistic "isms" as are any people of the land.

The Farmers' Demand.  
Now you ask me what this "real movement" is determined to have. Here is what they are committed to, and what every Candidate will be pledged to support. It is taken from their published platform:

(a) Protection is denounced in three separate paragraphs as wrong and vicious.

(b) "Immediate and substantial all round reductions in the customs tariff."

(c) "Increase in the British preference to fifty per cent, and free trade with Great Britain in five years."

(d) "Unrestricted reciprocity with the United States."

(e) "Free entry of all foodstuffs into Canada."

(f) "Free entry of all implements, farm and household machinery, of all vehicles, coal, lumber, cement, and quite a list of other articles."

I put this to the people of Montreal tonight, just as I put it to the people of Portage La Prairie last Tuesday night—do you want that policy for Canada? Don't you agree that that policy means the wiping out of protection in the tariff of this country? It means that first of all because they denounce the whole principle of protection. It means that secondly, because you can't wipe out the tariff on all implements of production, household utensils, on all foodstuffs, on a dozen and more other things of goods—indeed, on almost everything we have to have in this country—and then maintain protection on anything else. How can any serious man or woman think of stripping every shred of protection from the vital industries of this country, and then offer far less important industries with no measure of protection? Such a thing never was done anywhere and never can be done. It is unjust, it is discriminatory, it is impossible, it is wrong. Therefore, I say that platform means the abolition of the protective system in this country, and I say that the people of Canada here in New Brunswick, where else, must decide right now whether they are ready to abandon the protective system or whether they are not. I add just this, if you are not ready, hadn't you better take my straight, open, certain way of supporting the protective system by fighting those who fight the protective system? It is not that the man who is square thing to do and isn't it the only safe thing to do? That question I lay in the minds of every person within reach of my voice and I ask you to keep that question in your mind and never let it escape until you answer it on election day. That is the question that really you decide when you vote in this momentous contest.

Fight Foes of Protection.  
Now you ask me, why talk about protection? Are not the Mackenzie King Liberals who are running in this city all in favor of protection? Well, I will tell you why I talk about protection. I talk about protection because in this battle I have seen my face against and for against its opponents.

Mrs. Taylor reported that the Lancaster Hospital was now very full and that convalescent patients had been received from the wife and family of one of the patients who had died in August. ## Large Attendance At Temperance Rally

Despite the inclemency of the weather there was a good large attendance at the temperance rally held at Pythian Castle Hall, Union street, last evening at the addresses of Rev. H. A. Goodwin and J. O'Connell. R. T. Hayes, M. J. A. was in the chair and after the public meeting ward workers gathered in conference to discuss plans for the work on election day.

Rev. Mr. Goodwin, who has been working in St. John, Albert, Westmorland and a part of Kings counties, gave a most encouraging report of the interest being taken in the campaign in the country and predicted a sweeping majority for the temperance forces when the vote was counted. He dealt with some of the campaign forces of the opposing forces and shattered them to atoms. He insisted one where they claimed Lloyd George was against prohibition, but they failed to implement the statement with any proof. In contradiction of their claim he quoted the British Premier, who at an early period of the war had said that England had three great enemies to fight—Germany, Austria and the liquor traffic. The liquor traffic, he said, was the greatest enemy of the British Empire. He said that the liquor traffic had fallen off fifty per cent, while in England, which did not have prohibition, it had greatly increased.

J. D. O'Connell, the second speaker, said he had been fighting the liquor business for a little over fifty years, having started when he was a little over ten years of age, and at that time he had made up his mind not only to stop himself but to try and make it impossible for others to be ruined by it. He freely admitted that it was the abuse not the use of it in which the harm lay, but he went on to say that he had seen too many ruined lives had been even one-quarter drunk had abused it, and this practically included everyone, so he felt justified in prohibiting the traffic.

The great evil lay in the treating habit and it was to get rid of this that he was in favor of legislation doing away with the legal sale of liquor, for that removed the temptation, the habit which covered the licensed liquor seller. He said he had never met the man who had paid for his first drink of liquor, it had always been given him by some one else, and it was this treat habit which was responsible for the drunkenness of the world. Every year would see the opposition to the prohibition law growing less, and in a very few years the call for its repeal would have passed away because the crop of users would not be recruited from the youth of the land.

In closing he made an eloquent appeal in the names of the 400,000 yearly filled drunkards graves, and in the name of all that was good and holy to go forth on October 10 and record their votes in favor of prohibition, and settle once and for all the matter.

## Plans Completed For Visitation

### Every Denomination Represented at Meeting—Leaders and Committees Appointed

If plans laid down yesterday for a religious visitation are carried out, St. John will be thoroughly canvassed and every individual listed as to their church preference. A meeting in the interests of the survey was held at the Board of Trade Rooms yesterday afternoon which was most representative of every denomination in the City and which was addressed by J. Sharpe Durham, International Superintendent of Home Visitation. L. W. Simms was chairman, Max Marcus secretary and Dr. Broderick vice-chairman.

Mr. Durham carefully explained the scheme of the survey and the meeting to be held on Thursday next at which visitors will be instructed. Visitors are to be enrolled on Sunday Oct. 2nd. They will be eighteen headquarters at which they will report on Friday October 7th. Returns after being tabulated at headquarters will be sent to the different parishes interested.

Mr. Durham is an enthusiastic and earnest speaker. The hearty support of all denominations has been given him and there is no doubt but that much benefit will follow. Cards of general invitation to join some church were shown and the cards, of questions to which visitors get answers. It was decided to have these questions printed in several languages. On motion of Judge Forbes the forms shown were adopted.

It was announced that Dr. Bridges had promised to dismiss pupils and teachers an hour earlier on Friday so that they may have their share in the work.

When the plan was presented to local Catholics, they were much interested in it, and got in touch with Rev. Bishop LeBlanc by telegram, as he is out of the city in his work, as from Toronto he heard his hearty approval. The purpose of the movement is to visit every home, give printed invitations to all the people, inviting them to attend the Sunday school, church or synagogue of their choice, and to secure records of the church connection or preference of every individual, which will be given to the pastor, priest, rabbi or organization preferred. It is presided by the St. John Council and Maritime Religious Education Council and International Sunday School Association, under the auspices of the Protestant, Catholic and Jewish Sunday schools, churches and synagogues. 
