DUCHESNAY, *Lieut. Col. Hon. Antoine Juschereau, J. P. C.*

S. of the late Colonel Michael Juschereau Duchesnay, who became at an early age an officer in the then 60th Regiment, retired to enjoy his patrimonial estates, and was eventually appointed Deputy Adjutant General of Militia; and of Hermine de Sallaberry, his wife. Is cousin of the other mem. of the Senate of the same name. Sat for Portneuf in Leg. Assembly, Can., from 1848 to 1851. Is a Seigneur of P. Q., and Lieut. Col. commanding 4th Battalion Portneuf Militia. Represented LaSalle division in Leg. Council,
