and the said Inspector shall give a certificate of the quality of such Flour according to the said Standard, but shall, nevertheless if required, brand on the barrels the quality of the Flour according to the Standard of Inspection under this Act.

Recital.

Acts 4 5 V., c. 89—11 V., c. 6—and 13 14 V., c. 29, declared permanent as amended by this Act. HI. And whereas it was the intention of the Legislature that the Acts amended by the said Act should, as so amended, be permanent Laws of this Province, but such an intention is rather implied than expressly stated, for avoiding doubts, it is declared and enacted that the Act aloresaid as hereby amended, and the Act passed in the eleventh year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "An Act to continue and amend the Act for the Inspection of 10 "Flour and Meal, and to provide for the Inspection of Outmeal," as amended by it,—and the Act passed in the Session held in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "An Act to regulate the "Inspection of Flour and Meal," as amended by both the Acts beforementioned and by this Act,—shall be and have been since the passing of the 15 Act first above cited, permanent Laws of this Province, and shall be in force until repealed by the Legislature thereof.
