shall be made, it shall be lawful for any party interested to inscribe the cause on the roll de droit, on giving notice thereof to the opposite party; and the hearing of the said cause on the merits, shall be proceeded with as in ordinary causes.

Doubts as to Writs of cermoved.

IV. And inasmuch as doubts have arisen respecting the legality 5 writs of cer. of the service of Writs of certiorari issued during the period betain cases re- tween the passing of the said Act and the passing of the Act amending the same passed in the 13th and 14th years of Her Majesty's Reign, Be it therefore declared and enacted that in all cases in which copies of such Writs have been served upon the 10 proper parties within the said period, such service is sufficient and legal.
