And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall be lawful and competent to the Courts of King's Bench in this Province and to each of them in all causes above the value of ten pounds sterling, in which any issue or issues of fact shall be raised, and it shall appear to such Court expedient and necessary for the due Administration of Justice, to decide such issue or issues so raised by the Trial and Verdict of a Jury, to empanel a Jury for that purpose by Writ of *Venire facias*, directed to the Sheriff of the District in which such Court shall sit, and such issue or issues thereupon to decide by the Verdict of such Jury in due course of Law, and in the manner and form as to all things directed and provided by the Ordinance herein before recited ; and in all cases above the value of ten pounds sterling, in which it shall appear to such Court to be expedient and necessary for the due administration of Justice, to decide any matter or matters of mere fact in controversy between the parties in such cases by the Trial and Verdict of a Jury, it shall also be lawful and competent to such Court, by an interlocutory order to point out the matter or matters of fact to be so decided by the Trial and Verdict of a Jury, at the discretion of such Court, and in the nature of a special issue to empanel a Jury for that purpose by writ of *Venire facias*, directed to the Sheriff of the District in which such Court shall sit, and such matter or matters of fact or special issue to decide by the Verdict of such Jury in due course of Law, and in the manner and form as to all things directed and provided by the Ordinance herein before recited
