I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 25rd ultimo, inclosing a transfer of the title of Giant's Tomb Island to yourself, and in reply to say that before acceptance it will be necessary for you to furnish an assignment under seal with an affidavit of execution by the subscribing witness, made in accordance with the provisions of section 54 of the Indian Act, Chapter 81 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, along with which should be sent the sum of \$1.00, the usual registration fee.

As regards the timber license covering Giant's Tomb Island, I beg to say that it is renewable yearly for the term of seven years from the 50th of April, 1910, upon compliance with terms of license and regulations.

The document is herewith returned for completion.
