I beg to inform you that when you visit the different reserves in your Agency, which you should do at stated intervals, the Department desires that you will enquire carefully with regard to the health of the Indians, as well as with respect to sanitary conditions. If any of the Indians are 111 and require medical treatmentyou should bring the cases to the at tention of the salaried medical officer, with a request that he shall give prompt attention to the same. If he does not render his services you should make report to that affect to the Department. It is your duty to see that the medical officers attend when necessary the Indians under their care.
