



Ottawa, June 26, 1914.

Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 19th instant wherein you inform the Department that the building is erected on rising ground which will admit of draining into a creek which empties into a lake, I have to request that you will send a profile plan showing the position of House, Lake and Creek, also stating whether the lake and creek are used, or are likely to be used, for drinking purposes, for the watering of stock, or for pleasure purposes, and if so, it will be impossible to drain into the creek. It is possible, however, that other means of drainage can be provided.
