To expect supposes a sufficient reason to consider that a thing will happen.

Ex.? I expect my brother to day.

J'attends mon trère aujourd'hui.

Here I use to expect because I have a reason to believe that he will come.

To wait is used in other cases.

Ex.: Wait for me,

Attendez-moi.

Wait until he comes.

Attendez jusqu'à ce qu'il arrive.

Louer

This verb has several meanings, 10 Meaning to glorify, to proclaim the glory of some body, something, it is translated by *To praise*,

Praise God, holy angels.

Louez Dieu, Eunts Anges.

20 Louer, meaning to obtain for a certain price the temporary use of a thing, is translated by to hire.

Ex.: I hired a horse for two days.

Je louai un cheval pour deux jours.

Je me procurai un cheval pour deux jours.

30 Louer meaning to grant the temporary use of a thing for a compensation, is translated by to let.

Ex.: To let a house to tourists.

Louer une maison aux touristes.

40 To hire out has the same meaning as to let.
