REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON BY-LAWS AND RULES.

To the Council of the District of Simcoe:

The Committee to whom it was referred to consider the By-Laws and

Rules necessary to be observed by the Council, beg leave to report:
That they have attentively gone over the "Standing Rules and Regulations of the Municipal Council of the Homo District," and are of opinion that, with certain alterations in clauses 42nd, 43rd and 50th, the whole may be properly adopted by the Municipal Council of the District of Simcoe, and declared to be their "Standing Rules and Regulations."

The alterations are as follows :

In the last line of clause 42nd, the word "one" should be changed into

In clause 43rd, seventh line, the whole words after "unless" should be expunged, and the following inserted :- "Intimation of such application shall "have been given by posting up notices of the same in at least four con-"spicuous places in each Township to which such petition may apply, of which places the house in which the last Township meeting of such Town ship was held, shall be one, and unless also a like intimation be transmitted "to the Clerk of the District Council, who shall post it up in a conspicuous " place in the Public Buildings at Barrie; and all this at least one month "previous to any such petition being presented."

In the lifth line of clause 50th, the word "five" should be changed into "three.

With these alterations the Committee beg to recommend the adoption of the said Standing Rules and Regulations.
