IT WOULD ENABLE THE PEOPLE TO BUY AND SELL WHERE THEY COULD DO SO TO THE BEST ADVANTAGE AND FREE THEM FROM THE EXACTIONS OF TRUSTS AND COMBINES. FREE TRADE WOULD RELEASE PARLIAMENT FROM THE DOMINATION OF THE PROTECTED INTERESTS AND REMOVE THE MOST FRUITFUL SOURCE OF POLITICAL CORRUPTION AND THE DEMORALIZATION OF OUR PUBLIC MEN. FREE TRADE WOULD ALSO REMOVE TEMPTATION FROM MEN AND WOMEN IN EVERY WALK OF LIFE, LAY AND CLERICAL, WHO ARE FREQUENTLY LED INTO DECEIT AND DISHONESTY TO EVADE THE LAWFUL, THOUGH UNJUST, PAYMENT OF CUSTOMS DUTIES.
