Some Informing Figures.
The latest Canadian Criminal statistics issued are those for 1908. They show an increase of crime, in ratio greater than the increase of population. The total convictions for crimes of all kinds in the year reported were 88,633. That there were 31,089 convictions for drunkenness alone shows, in part, the relation of the drink traffic to degradation and crime. But large as the figures are, they but faintly indicate the crime producing power of the traffic. Only a fraction of the drunk are arrested, and a considerable number of the arrested are not mentioned in the list of convictions. Besides, the crimes due to drink are a great host of every degree of seriousness, and make up the most of the larger total of criminal convictions, 88,633.
How delegatization of the liquor traffic affects drunkenness and crime is clearly shown by the 1908 records. For instance, the convictions for drunkenness in the whole of Canada were nearly five for every thousand of the population; in Prince Edward Island, under prohibition, there were less than two per thousand of population. For serious crimes the convictions in the whole of Canada were over seventeen per ten thousand of the population; in Prince Edward Island they were less than one and a half per ten thousand of population. Where the traffic is prohibited, disorder, mischief and crimes diminish.

Seventy-five Percent of Loggers
A nut for Mr. Hawthornthwaite to crack.
During the year 1907, as reported by Mr. A. Haslam, supervisor of scales, there was cut and removed by the logging firms of British Columbia, timber to the amount of 600,000,000 feet. Upon this the Government collected royalty. How much was cut from the forests of Vancouver Island, Mr. Haslam could not say. The cost of cutting and removing timber is made up of several items, the greatest being that of labor. It has been variously estimated by men operating camps, both on this side and on the American side, that the cost per thousand feet paid to labor in 1907, clear of the amount charged for board, was from \$3 to \$5. If the cost per thousand paid to labor was as high as \$5, then the men working in the logging camps of B. C. received during that year, clear of their board, \$3,600,000. How much of this amount was saved by the men? Not 25 percent. More than 75 percent was spent for strong drink, which means, if these figures are correct, that \$5,000,000 was spent that way and \$900,000 went for necessities. No one who knows will contend that more than 25 percent of the amount paid to loggers is spent for necessities at any time, 1907 or any other year. I have wondered if Mr. Hawthornthwaite would have made use of the same language in opposition to the Local Option bill if he had had these facts before him. The city of Vancouver was feeding some of these very men the following season—Local Option.

British Labor Leaders Advocate Temperance Reform.
President Rutherford, of the British Board of Education, speaking recently to a great audience on temperance, said: "There has never been a workman who rose above the rank of his class and obtained great distinction as a labor leader who was not at the same time a temperance reformer. Look through the list of the labor members of the House of Commons and there you will find a larger proportion of temperance men than in any other part of that house. For the simple reason that those men know the conditions of their own class and they have been brought face to face with the greatest evils associated with strong drink."
Bishop W. S. Wilson declares that the use of cigarettes are being given away in West China in the effort to introduce the cigarette habit into that country. The vendors even parade the "cotton" units as a cure for the opium habit. "Barley" China, the troublemaker of her own without being forced to contend with our Western vice!
