THE MOTHER OF CHURCHES. I.—THE BASILICA AT QUEBEC. On Saturday, October 27, the Quebec festival was the scene of the most extraordinary religious and patriotic display.

THE MOTHER OF CHURCHES. II.—THE BASILICA AT QUEBEC. The child carried in her hand a golden urn, which she bore carefully, because it was full to the brim.

THE MOTHER OF CHURCHES. III.—THE BASILICA AT QUEBEC. The widow fell upon her knees in a kind of ecstasy, and returned thanks to God, repeating over and over again, "Oh my God! how beautiful—how much happier is my daughter in Heaven!"

THE MOTHER OF CHURCHES. IV.—THE BASILICA AT QUEBEC. The bishops of the other provinces of Canada who were consecrated in the Quebec basilica are these: 1788, Bishop O'Donnell, first bishop of Newfoundland.

THE MOTHER OF CHURCHES. V.—THE BASILICA AT QUEBEC. 1820, Bishop Macdonnell, first bishop of Upper Canada (Kingston). 1821, Bishop Macdonnell, first bishop of Prince Edward Island.

THE MOTHER OF CHURCHES. VI.—THE BASILICA AT QUEBEC. In a broader sense, old Quebec may be set down as the central and distributing point of the church in North America.

THE MOTHER OF CHURCHES. VII.—THE BASILICA AT QUEBEC. The church of St. Dominge is older, founded in 1614. That of Mexico dates from 1524, and that of Havana was established still earlier.

THE MOTHER OF CHURCHES. VIII.—THE BASILICA AT QUEBEC. In 1863 he founded the Farmers' Bank of Rastio, with a capital of \$9,000, an institution which has been and still is an inalienable boon to the Acadians.

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
