

SITES OF DEMONSTRATION FARMS ARE ANNOUNCED

Medicine Hat, Claresholm, Olds, Sedgewick, Stony Plain, Vermilion, Athabasca Landing.

DEPARTMENT GIVES REASON FOR CHOICE Geography, Soil and Climate All Taken Into Consideration Says the Minister.

Work Will be Started on the Farms at Once—Hon. Duncan Marshall Has Left for Medicine Hat to Select a Building Site and Have Operations Begun There—Mr. Craig Goes to Vermilion.

(From Thursday's Daily.) Announcement was made yesterday by the Hon. Duncan Marshall, minister of agriculture, of the locations of the demonstration farms to be established this year throughout the province.

Locations of Farms: The exact locations of the farms are: Medicine Hat—section 11, township 13, range 6, west 4th.
