## SIDE TALKS.

### ABOVE ALL, DON'T GET BITTER



There is nothing  
in the world so  
easy as to get bit-  
ter when one feels  
one has been un-  
justly treated either by  
some individual or  
by life itself.

And there is noth-  
ing in the world  
so fatal to further happiness, so an-  
tagonizing to others and so cumula-  
tive in its bad effects on oneself, as  
to get a bitter outlook on life.

"I just hate to hear Mrs. Burrage  
talk about her husband," one of my  
neighbors said recently. "She's so  
bitter. It's really unpleasant to see  
her face."

"But, my dear, think how, he's  
treated her. Don't you think it's  
enough to make any woman bitter?"  
queried her friend.

The Way Everyone Feels.  
"Yes, I suppose so," admitted  
the first woman. "But just the same  
I hate to hear her. Her face looks  
so horrible and her voice sounds so  
harsh. And she wants to talk about  
it all the time, too. I never go near  
her if I can help it, but I got caught  
beside her in the trolley the other  
day."

Perhaps you may call that an un-  
sympathetic attitude.

So it is. But it is also the typical  
human reaction toward bitterness of  
any kind. People do not always  
phrase it so frankly, but I think they  
all feel it.

No one, no matter what his or her  
provocation, can afford to be bitter.  
That is, no one who still cares about  
human love and sympathy and com-  
panionship.

It does not matter what one's pro-  
vocation is. People may admit that  
you have plenty of reason, but that  
will not change their emotional reac-  
tion, which is one of avoidance and  
dislike.

She Alienated Sympathy.

"I once knew two sisters who quar-  
relled over a matter of land. The one  
really seemed to have the right on her

side but she let the other have her  
way rather than to take it to court.  
Almost everyone agreed that she had  
the right of it but she was so acid,  
so resentful, so bitter, and the other  
was so cheerful so placidly indifferent  
about the whole matter (why not  
when she got her way) that somehow  
she managed to hold the larger vol-  
ume of friends when the two split.

Unjust, yes, but not unnatural. If  
the first had been less resentful and  
bitter in her rightness, I think she  
would have had universal sympathy.

Like an Unpleasant Smell.

We don't like bitterness any more  
than we like an unpleasant smell or a  
harsh noise or an ugly site. We don't  
stop to ask what causes it. We just  
dislike it and try to get away from  
it.

The sense of being disliked and  
avoided makes the bitter person even  
more bitter. So the cruel circle runs.  
The jealous man, someone has said,  
poisons his own banquet and then eats  
it. So does the bitter one.

Watch yourself when things go  
wrong and don't let yourself start  
getting bitter. Don't say that you  
have justification. That won't help  
you the least bit in the world. Just  
say you won't be bitter because it is  
yourself who is going to be made un-  
happy if you do.
