SIXTH YEAR POUNDMAKER IN PRIS. THE GREAT CHIEF AND ALL HEAD MEN SURRENDER. A Large Part of the Prisoners and a Search Instituted for the Big Bear the Hero of the Otter River, May 27.—Before the attack on the head men, the militia announced that he was in a telegram from Gen. Middleton, he thought would be of interest to the public.
