LEGAL DECISIONS REGARDING NEWSPAPERS.

- 1. Any person who takes a paper regularly from the post office whether directed in his name or anothers, or whether he has subscribed or not, is responsible for payment.
- 2. If a person orders his paper discontinued, he must pay all arrears, or the publisher may continue to send it until payment is made, and then collect the whole amount, whether the paper is taken from the office or not.
- 3. In suits for subscriptions, the suit may be instituted in the place where the paper is published, although the subscriber may reside hundreds of miles away.
- 4. The courts have decided that refusing to take newspapers or periodicals from the post office, or removing and leaving them uncalled or, while unpaid, is "prima facie" evidence of intentional fraud.
