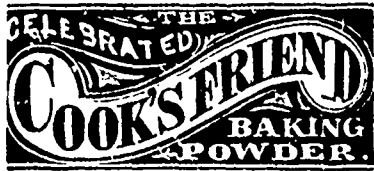

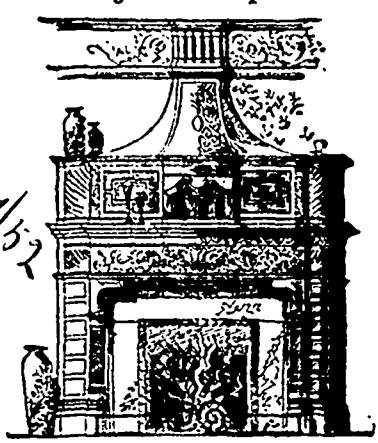

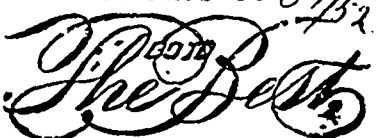

HAMILTON.—An adjourned meeting will be held in St. Paul's Church, Hamilton on Wednesday, August 7, at half-past nine a.m.

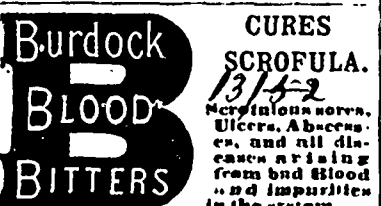
