

EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF PERU CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT PERMITTING THE GOVERNMENT OF PERU TO CONSTITUTE AMATEUR STATIONS IN CANADA AND PERU FOR EXCHANGE OF MESSAGES BY OTHER COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS THAN THE TELEPHONE SYSTEMS.

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conditions:

Amateur stations of Canada and Peru may exchange messages or other communications from or to third parties, provided:

(a) the amateur stations exchange such third party communications and not paid any direct or indirect compensation therefor; and

(b) such communications shall be limited to conversations or messages of a technical or personal nature, for which by reason of their unique character, recourse to the public telecommunications service is not justified.

If the Government of Peru is prepared to accept the foregoing provisions I have the honor to suggest that this Note and your reply thereto shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall have effect from the date of your reply. This Agreement shall be subject to termination at any time on sixty days notice by either Government.
