CULTURAL GRANT MADE TO CAPE BRETON SYMPHONY

The Honourable Barbara McDougall, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announced today that a grant of \$40,000 has been made to Cape Breton Symphony Fiddlers to assist in the group's tour of the United Kingdom from August 23 to September 13, 1992.

The grant was made under the International Cultural Relations Program, which is part of External Affairs and International Trade Canada. This program supports activities in the arts and education, and exchanges of cultural personalities. Tours such as those of the Cape Breton Symphony Fiddlers help demonstrate excellence in Canadian cultural creativity, both nationally and internationally.

Under the direction of Bobby Brown, the Cape Breton Symphony Fiddlers will give 16 concerts of their show 'Cape Breton Salutes Great Britain' in England and Scotland.
