- (f) the discussion under the motion must not raise any question which, according to the standing orders of the House, can only be debated on a distinct motion under notice.
- 27. A copy of the Journals of this Certified copy of Journals for House, certified by the Clerk, shall be Governor General.

CHAPTER III

RULES OF DEBATE

- 28. Every member desiring to speak Member speaking. is to rise in his place, uncovered, and address himself to Mr. Speaker.
- 29. When two or more members rise Members rising simulto speak, Mr. Speaker calls upon the taneously. member who first rose in his place; but a motion may be made that any member who has risen "be now heard", or "do now speak", which motion shall be forthwith put without debate.
