should be made in the future to keep manuscripts in the Library. As a member of the McCord Committee, I feel that the Museum should concentrate on objects rather than books and manuscripts. The former are meant to be looked at, which is a function of a museum; the latter are intended to be studied or copied, which is a function of a library.

I do not wish, for the moment, to involve the question of transferring manuscripts or books at present in the McCord Museum. I merely suggest a desirable policy for the Committee to adopt with regard to future donations.
