

book of constitution, the lodge book, and the book of his office, one after another; and the Grand Master or his Deputy, shall charge suitable to the article presented.

The members of the new lodge bowing unto the new Master, shall return thanks, and immediately salute their new Master, and signify their subjection and obedience to him, by the ancient form.

The Grand Wardens, and any other officers that are not members of the new lodge, shall salute the new Master; and he shall return salute to the Grand Master first, and to the other officers.

The new Master desires the new Master to enter upon the exercise of his office, in naming his new Master, calling forth the two brethren to the Grand Master for his approbation, and the Senior or Junior Grand Warden, in charge of Wardens; and the candidates proposed by the new Master shall signify their consent.

The new Master shall present them with their office, and induct them in due form; and the brethren shall signify their consent to the new Wardens by the usual congratulation. The officers of the lodge, and those appointed to be officers, shall salute the new Master in ancient form.

Being thus completely constituted, shall be notified by due notice, shall be sent to every lodge in
