therefore, to have been followed as the balis and fure foundation of all good government in this country, of which they afforded fo recent and fo diffinguished an example; and you should have confidered as your worst enemy the first man who removed the finallest stone in the structure of this folid fabric. Strange as it will tell to posterity, this body of experience was not sapped by degrees, but at once, totally and in all its parts overthrown, by those who were called to the administration speedily after his present Majesty's accession; and every publie measure of any importance pursued in the present reign, with the exception which I shall have occasion to mention hereafter, hath been founded upon principles directly opposed to it. As if the public happiness were a fubject of envy to the courtiers then for the first time brought forward, the conduct which had produced it was to be reverfed, and a fresh trial was to be made of thole 2
