

RAY AGAIN LANDS PHYLLIS ADMIRAL

In Straight Heats on the Third
Day at Mount
Clemens.

LUCY C. WINS FROM MAEO

Canadian Mare Tired in Pace
After Winning Heat in
Fast Time.

Mount Clemens, Mich., Jan. 15.—Fair and a warm sun greeted the opening of the third day's racing at the Mount Clemens Driving Club at Clinton View Park, and some of the best racing of the week was witnessed by a large crowd.

The first race called was the 224 pace, in which the Canadian mare, Maeo, sold as favorite over the field, but after winning the first heat she tired and was beaten by Lucy C. an Oklahoma pony. The judges estimated Jim Fogarty beat Maeo in the third heat, but the mare showed the effects of her hard racing on Monday and Tuesday, and she threw a shoe, and was placed by the judges.

In the trotting event Phyllis Admiral, a winner on the opening day, again sold as favorite and won easily in straight heats. In the second heat Harry Hoffman made a fine drive with Oak Tree, and had a chance to win except for some interference due to a break in front of him, and he trotted very fast, could not catch the speedy Phyllis, who had Nat Ray as pilot today.
