

\$100 A MONTH IS PLEGGED TO KEEP McLACHLAN FAMILY

C. P. R. Employees to Help
N. S. Strike Leader's
Dependents

Montreal, Jan. 11.—One hundred dollars a month to support his wife and nine children of J. B. McLachlan, Nova Scotia miners' strike leader, now serving a two years' sentence for sedition, has been pledged by the Canadian Pacific Railway System Federation Local Council, Montreal, the money to be subscribed as long as McLachlan remains in jail.

The bulk of the money is being subscribed in the C. P. R. Angus shops, it is understood.

An appeal to the Minister of Justice to release McLachlan is being sent by District Lodge 82, International Association of Machinists, comprising about three lodges with a membership of 2,000 men.

A Montreal branch of the Nova Scotia defence committee has been formed with a view to raising funds in support of McLachlan. Tickets are being sold in the city for a dance in aid of the defence funds, the tickets bearing a picture of a prisoner behind the bars.

PARRBORO LUMBERING.

Lumbering operations are quite brisk along the Parrboro shore, this winter, according to the reports of the millmen who are in town from those districts, says the Amherst News. The weather conditions have been fairly satisfactory and the roads are now in fairly good shape for hauling. The biggest operators in the Porterville district is the Schofield Co., whose various contracts will total about 3,000,000 feet. Warden Soley hopes to have a cut of about 750,000, while Giesner Kerr will have about 300,000, and Taylor & Field will probably have 400,000. Seaman & Murphy, who are operating at Porterville and Soley, will have a cut of about 300,000 in the former place and 400,000 in the latter. The cut of smaller operators would indicate that something like 7,000,000 feet of lumber will be moving along the Parrboro shore during the coming season.

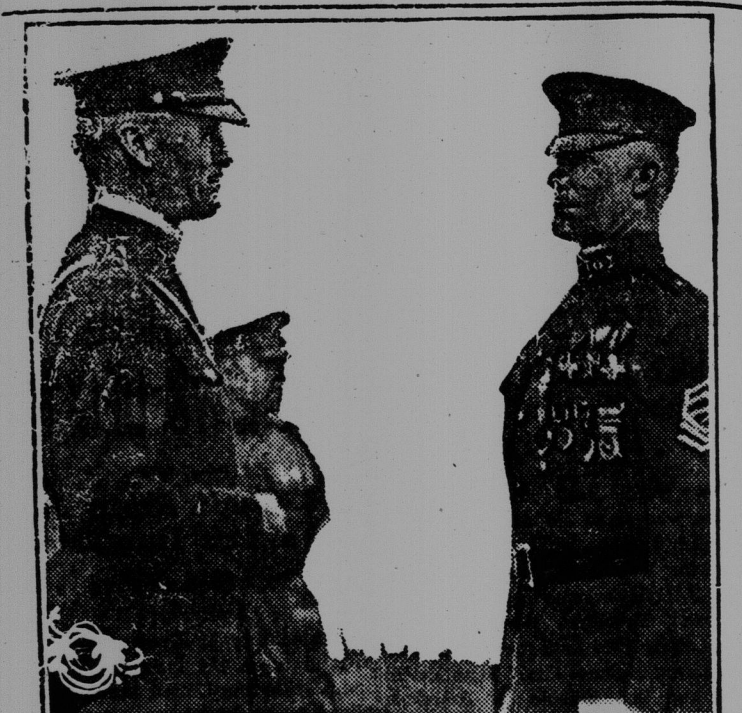

BECK VINDICATED IN GREGORY REPORT

Premier Ferguson Says the
Findings are an Endorsement
of Chairman.

(By E. George Smith, Staff Correspondent of The Globe)

Niagara Falls, Jan. 8.—"I am glad to tell you, by my knowledge of what the contents of the Gregory Commission report will be, that it is a complete vindication of the whole Chippewa development scheme, and an endorsement of the ability and integrity of the man who originated the scheme, Sir Adam Beck."

Amidst the enthusiastic applause of members of his Cabinet, the Mayor and Councilors of Niagara Falls, and scores of Hydro officials and engineers who have planned and shaped Ontario's immense power development plan, Premier Ferguson made this announcement as to the tenor of the Gregory report, in the Chippewa power plant today.

New Province 450,000 horsepower.

The occasion was that of the turning on by the Premier of Chippewa's sixth unit, which will add 450,000 horsepower to the total output of the plant, and bring the total available for Ontario domestic and industrial light and power users from this one plant up to 3,500,000 horsepower. Chippewa's plans call for 12 units, the last of which will be completed in 10 years' time.

Following brief after-dinner speeches by Sir Adam Beck and Premier Ferguson, the gathering of 250 admirers of the power house main floor, journeyed to the power house main floor, where Premier Ferguson turned the control lever which released the flood of water from 300 feet overhead. With a roar and roar it launched its mighty force against the underground turbines, which in turn whirled and electricity was being made in Chippewa's sixth unit.

Big Sign First Lighted.

Movies and cameramen snapped away meanwhile at the Ferguson Cabinet, the members of which, with the exception of Hon. Robert Cochrane and Hon. Thomas Crawford, closely surrounded Premier Ferguson as he let loose the flood of water.

RAILWAY MAN IS DEAD, AGED 71

Hartland, Jan. 10.—(Special).—The death of Aneurin Alton occurred at 8.30. Mr. Alton has been helpless from the effects of paralysis for the past two years, and another stroke came on Tuesday afternoon from which he did not rally. Mr. Alton is survived by his aged wife and eight children, five sons, Frank and Herbert of Hartland; David, of Oxbow, Victoria Co.; Robert and George in the West, and three daughters, Mrs. B. M. Berry, of Green River; Mrs. Roy Stevens, of East Florenceville; and Mrs. A. C. Carr, of Kamloops, B. C.

The late Mr. Alton was born in Scotland 71 years ago, and came to Canada in his early youth, as a young man he joined the service of the railway, and for many years he was employed on this division as section foreman. Then he succeeded to the position of track master, which position he held for nearly 20 years, up until the time of his illness, when he was superannuated.

Mr. Alton was a man much looked up to in this community and had a high sense of honor, and besides relatives he leaves a large circle of friends, both among the townspeople and also among the people with whom he worked.
