INDEPENDENCE OF EGYPT
Demonstrations Over Telegram From U. S. That Had Poor Foundation
London, Sept. 2.—(By the Associated Press)—Great enthusiastic demonstrations were held in Cairo and Alexandria on Saturday and Sunday in consequence of the receipt of a telegram declaring that the foreign relations committee of the Egyptian senate had declared that Egypt should be independent according to a Cairo dispatch to the Daily Mail. It is said that Said Pasha Zagloul, head of the Egyptian national liberation movement, was the author of the telegram to Cairo.
No action has been taken by the foreign relations committee of the senate regarding Egypt that would seem to warrant demonstrations in that country. The committee recently gave a hearing in which the claims of the Egyptian nationalists were voiced, but no further action has been taken by the committee.
