## Daily Hints For the Cook

**Hard and Liquid Sauces**  
Hard Sauce—One-third cup butter and 1/4 cup powdered sugar creamed together, then add one tablespoon hot milk, one and a half teaspoons lemon, one teaspoon vanilla. When nice and creamy pile lightly in a dish and put on ice until wanted.  
Liquid Sauce—Mix half cup sugar and two teaspoons cornstarch and add one cup boiling water. Cook until clear. Add butter size of walnut and any flavoring desired.

**English Bath Buns**  
Sift one quart flour into bowl, add half teaspoon salt. Make hole in center and break in four eggs, then add three-quarter cup lukewarm milk, in which dissolve one yeast cake and half cup butter. Mix thoroughly with spoon and set aside to rise in a warm place one and a half hours. When light, turn out on floured board and sprinkle with five tablespoons sugar and three tablespoons chopped almonds, and work them into the mass by drawing the tips of fingers lightly and quickly through the dough. Do not knead. Then drop by spoonfuls half inch apart, into greased pans. Let rise ten minutes. Bake in hot oven. This makes two dozen. Process takes about two hours and fifteen minutes.

**KISSING THE BLARNEY STONE**  
Only One in 10,000 Succeeded in Performing the Rite

A good many people who take a trip to Europe tell lies when they come back," said the globe trotter. "One thing they like to lie about is kissing the Blarney Stone.

"A lot of travelers say they have performed that osculatory stunt, and they dilate on the experience with a glossiness that gives color to their assertion. Maybe a few of them really have accomplished the feat, but their number stands in the proportion to those who have not as 1 to 1,000.

Kissing the Blarney Stone is not an easy thing to do. If the boasters would only look up a few facts in the case and find out what difficulties are encountered in performing the rite they would have less to say on the subject.

"In the first place, the precious stone is near the top of one of the great towers of the castle. To reach it you would have to climb 125 feet inside of a dark cavernous donjon. Then, when you have come to the nearest opening in the massive wall, you have to be hung out of the window head downward, over a parapet, by the heels. Even when suspended in this inverted position a person has to be about seven feet tall in order to reach the stone and imprint thereon the devotional smack.

"Considering this acrobatic feat and the length of body required, a lot of travelers of the saved-off type would do well to think of the Blarney Stone from their list of adventures."—New York Times.

**Verdict in Ross Case**  
A verdict was reached in the inquest into the death of Ernest Ross, the deck-hand who was drowned off a scow operated by the Norton Griffiths Dredging Company on July 14, in Courtney Bay, last night. The jury being only thirty minutes. The verdict was that Ross met his death by drowning, with a clause to the effect that insufficient protection was accorded him by the company on the day in question, and that two men should be sent out on scows when the weather conditions were similar to those on the day Ross was drowned.

The publication is being distributed by the marine department and titled "Fish and How to Cook It." 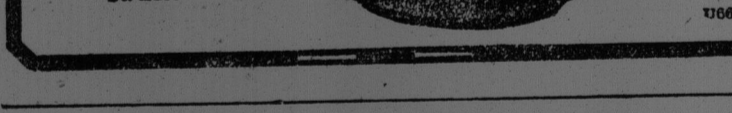

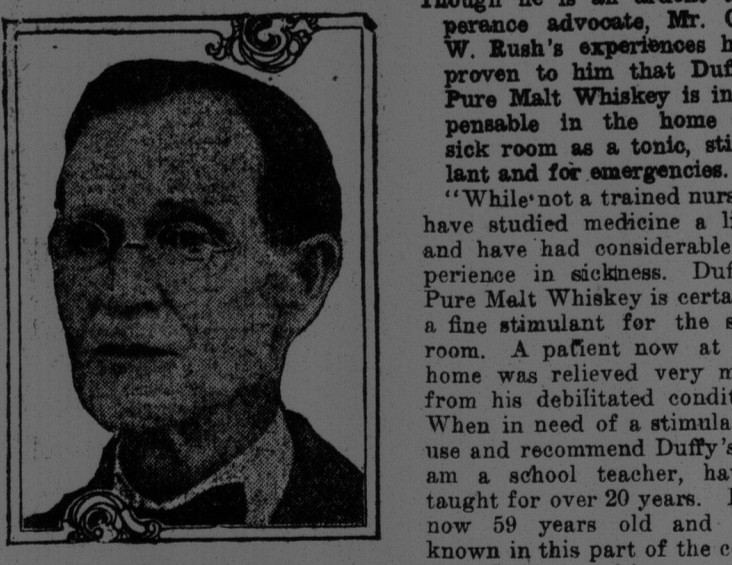
