BRITISH PARLIAMENT.

MONTREAL, April 21.—A special London cable says:

"The British parliament reassembled today.

"General Laurier has a bill before parliament which aims to put graduates of colonial medical colleges on the same footing as British graduates in the army and navy services and in the colonies generally. The other Canadian born members are also active this session.

"Sir Gilbert Parker's deceased wife's sister marriage bill will be brought down on May 1st. He counts on receiving the support of all the Canadian members for his measure and also for his forthcoming motion dealing with the question of Canadian meat.

"Dr. McNamara, who was born in Quebec and who is the leading expert on British education affairs, will lead the attack again on the government bill abolishing the London school board."

NO ANARCHISTS WANTED.

BOSTON, April 21.—Hereafter the alien will find difficulty in securing his naturalization papers from the clerk of the United States district court, and owing to the efforts of the immigration department and the act of congress on March 3, several clauses have been inserted by which the would-be citizen must swear that he is not an anarchist or possessed of anarchistic motives. This new paper, with which is attached several important clauses, will be put in the clerk's office on June 1, when the new law will go into effect.

ST. JOHN, N. B., April 21.—The seal fishery this year will result in a total catch of at least 315,000 seals, as against 274,000 seals caught last year. The price this year is higher. The total value of the seal product last year amounted to \$23,000; it will probably reach \$100,000 this year. It does it will have been the most successful seal hunt in the history of the colony.

BAXTER AND TILLEY ELECTED

No Interest in Election Except in Carleton.

The civic election passed off very quietly yesterday; in fact, it was difficult to discover that there was a contest on. The people of the north and south ends felt little concern as to what men should represent the two wards on the west side. It was a bitter fight over there, however.

Ald. J. B. M. Baxter won out over ex-Ald. I. E. Smith by 763 votes, more than doubling the vote polled by Mr. Smith. In one ward only, Lorne, did Mr. Smith come out ahead.

Chas. F. Tilley, the successful candidate for the representation of Guys ward, defeated ex-Ald. W. D. Baskin by 105 votes and C. W. Belyea by 287 votes, polling himself 736. Mr. Tilley was victorious in nine of the thirteen wards. The total vote was about 3,000, so that the polling was short.

There was a big crowd at the City Hall to get the returns, and the first came in about 4:15. It was 5:30 when the vote for Guys was received. The vote is here given.
