tendency of wheat was effectively  
checked and prices scored gains of  
more than 1 cent today owing to un-  
favorable weather for harvesting in  
the southwest and to a "green bug"  
scare in the oats market. At the close  
prices showed net advances of 1 1/8  
to 1 1/2 to 1 5/8. Corn and oats also  
advanced substantial gains but provisions  
were weak.
