

to be a public Act, and shall be judicially taken notice of as such by all Judges, Justices, and others, without being specially pleaded.

LIV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that this Act shall commence and take effect on the day on which the Trustees shall hold their first meeting, and shall be put in execution and continue in force from thenceforth and during the term of fifty years then next ensuing, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of Parliament.
