S. of the late Hon. J. A. Panet, for many years Speaker of the L. A. of L. C., and a mem. of the L. C. of same Province. B. in Quebec. M. Miss Oliva, dau. of Dr. Oliva, of St. Thomas, P. Q. Is Lieut.-Col. commanding 1st Batt. Quebec Militia. Sat as a life mem. in L. C., Can., from Oct., 1852, until the Union. Called to present House, 1867.—*St. Lewis St., Quebec.*

PROULX, *Hon. JEAN BAPTISTE GEORGE.* [*De La Vallière.*]

Sat for De La Vallière in the L. C., Can., from 1860 until the Union. Called to present House, 1867.—*Nicolet, P. Q.*

PRUD'HOMME, *Hon. J. EUSTACHE.* [*Rigaud.*]

Sat for Rigaud in L. C., Can., from 1863 until the Union. Called to present House, 1867.—*Tannery West, P. Q.*

RODIER, *Hon. CHARLES SÉRAPHIN.* [*De Lorimier.*]

B. in Montreal, 4 Oct., 1797. Ed. at the College of St. Sulpice. M., Sept., 1826, Marie Louise, dau. of Col. de Lacroix. Was for many years in business as a wholesale merchant. Called to the Bar, L. C., 1841. Was elected Mayor of Montreal for four successive terms, and in that capacity
