been regularly kept, or shall be proved to be erroneous, then the amount of such debt shall be held to be a sum equal to the then last year's receipts of such office, for a like period, and that sum may be recovered accordingly 5 by the Crown with costs; and any moneys paid over to the Receiver-General under this Act shall form part of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, and if in any case, A certain salthe sum actually received as aforesaid by any Register ary assured to each Register, shall not be equal to his salary for the time, at the rate per annum, the balance shall be paid to him out of the said Consolidated Revenue Fund.
