

VI. Whereas a large number of individuals obtained from the said Municipal Council food, provisions, and other necessities as aforesaid, whose names are as yet unknown to the Clerk of the Municipality of the Township of Arthur, it is therefore further enacted that in case it shall be discovered after such Roll is placed in the Collector's hands, under this Act, that any party or parties other than those named in the said Collector's Roll have obtained food, provisions and relief from the said Municipal Council, under the said Act, it shall be lawful for the Clerk of the Municipality of the Township of Arthur to add the name of such party or parties to the said Roll, with the particulars in the third section of this Act provided, and the Collector shall collect the amounts due by, and proceed against such party or parties in the same manner as if their names had been upon the original Roll handed to him.

Provision in case other parties than those on the Collector's Roll are found to have received advances.

VII. It shall be the duty of the Collector of the Township of Arthur to collect each instalment, with per centage and interest as aforesaid, as it respectively falls due, with as little delay as possible; and it shall be his further duty, on the first day of each month, to furnish to the Treasurer of the Municipality of the Township of Arthur a correct list, sworn to on oath, before any Justice of the Peace of the County of Wellington, of all the parties from whom he has collected money during the month next preceding, and a correct account of the amount paid by each individual, and at the same time to pay over the amount so collected to the Treasurer of the said Municipality.

Collector bound to collect and account for the said monies.

VIII. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
