VII. It shall be the duty of the Collector of the Township of Arthur Collector 15 to collect each instalment, with per centage and interest as aforesaid, as it respectively falls due, with as little delay as possible; and it shall be his further duty, on the first day of each month, to furnish to the Treasurer said monies. of the Municipality of the Township of Arthur a correct list, aworn to on oath, before any Justice of the Peace of the County of Wellington, of all 20 the parties from whom he has collected money during the month next preceding, and a correct account of the amount paid by each individual, and at the same time to pay over the amount so collected to the Treasurer of the said Municipality.
