

CANADA (TRANSPORT OF TROOPS, &c.)

RETURN to an Address of the Honourable The House of Commons,  
dated 6 April 1865;—for,

“RETURNS of the SUMS Paid out of the IMPERIAL TREASURY during the  
Years 1862, 1863, and 1864, for the TRANSPORT of TROOPS to *Canada*;  
the Expense of Maintaining them while there; for Arms and Military  
Stores of all kinds; whether for the Use of the Regular Troops or of the  
Canadian Militia and Volunteers; or for any other Object connected with  
the Defence of *Canada*:”

“And, of all SUMS Expended by the COLONIAL GOVERNMENT during the  
Years 1862, 1863, and 1864, for the Pay or Clothing of VOLUNTEERS;  
for providing Arms and Stores; or for any other Object connected with  
the Defence of *Canada*.”
