My dear Doctor:

Many thanks for your letter of the 12th instant. I am glad to have the suggestions which it contains, and with your permission will deal with the subjects of which it makes mention. I have had in mind speaking of Sir Wilfrid's conflicts abroad, and will be particularly glad to have a chance to do so on that occasion.
