We, the undersigned, Chief and Councillors of the Peguis Band, having discussed the matter of the Annuity money of the family of W. J. Flett, #960 Peguis Band, make the following request to our Indian Agent that he may get a ruling on same from the Dept. of Indian Affairs at Ottawa.

That the annuity and Interest monies of the four children of the above named, who are at the Indian Residential School at Fort Alexander, be kept for these children until such time as they leave the school.

Our explanation for the above request is that W. J. Flett is not supporting his family and is also living separated from his wife, consequently the family receive no benefit from their monies. A brother of the above children, now supporting himself, asked the Chief and Council if the monies could be funded until the children leave school.
