Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant, in which you make report relative to shoes and clothing required by certain Indians of your agency: and in reply I beg to say that the undermentioned amounts may be expended in the purchase of necessary articles such as referred to, in the following manner, namely:-

Daisy Brooks	St. Mary's Reserve	\$9.50
Susan Macchie	"	5.50
Two Macchie children	"	5.50 each
Geo. Macchie's children	"	4.50

With reference to your letter also of the 26th instant, I beg to say that the Department approves of your having incurred an expenditure of \$1.05 in moving Nellie Macchie, who is suffering from tuberculosis, to the house referred to which is near the residence of Isaac Paul. The Department observes your remark that Mrs. Isaac Paul, sister of the sick woman, will give her necessary attention.
