
I beg to confirm the following telegram sent you today, viz:-

"Reference yours sixth instant, accept Eaton Company quotation on wire. Shipping instructions by mail".

Shipment of 100 rolls of wire and 150 lbs. of staples should be made to Duck Lake station; 108 rolls and 160 lbs of staples to Dundurn station for Whitecap Sioux Reserve. Freight charges should be prepaid by requisition. You should advise the Indian Agent at Duck Lake of the shipment to Dundurn as well as to Duck Lake, also advise the Overseer at Whitecap Sioux Reserve.

T. Eaton Company's account should be certified by you and forwarded to the Department for payment.
