Dear Mr. Graham:

In reply to your letter of the 28th instant, No. 9-20, in regard to the transfer of the lease of sec. 8, Tp. 20, Rge. 19, W. 4, N. 12, S. 1, I beg to say that the Department could not take the position of accepting a transfer of the lease of this lease, but it is possible that the Department could transfer, providing you are able to pay the balance of course, assuming all conditions of the lease.

Your acceptance of transfer of the lease would be looked to for fulfillment of the conditions of the lease and the original lease, of course, relieved of further obligation.

As regards the question of the lease, it must be left undisturbed until the lease can be given for removal thereof.
