- ✓ 1. Minister of Agriculture
 - - State of Canadian agriculture.
 - - Policy of security and guidance for farmers.
 - + Marketing legislation.
 - ✓ Extension of P.F.R.A. to Eastern Canada.

- ✓ 2. Minister of Finance
 - ✓ - Progress in decontrol programme and policies for the future.
 - ✓ - Dominion-Provincial relations (Not possible to work out paragraph until immediately before opening of Parliament)
 - ✓ - Revision of Income Tax legislation if inter-departmental committee completes task.

- ✓ 3. Minister of Labour
 - ✓ - Rehabilitation of war workers and veterans.
 - ✓ - Vocational training and apprenticeship training.
 - ✓ - Polish veterans.
 - ✓ - Amendments to the Industrial Disputes Investigation Act.
 - ✓ - Level of employment. Increase over 1939.

- ✓ 4. Minister of Mines and Resources.
 - - Repeal of Chinese Immigration Act.
 - ✓ - Widening of immigration regulations. Study being conducted of future immigration policy.
 - ✓ - Extension of franchise to inhabitants of Mackenzie District of N.W.T. by adding that district to constituency of Yukon.
