Extract from letter of same date from the Prime Minister to Hon. P. J. A. Cardin:

I gave the strongest reasons why this false impression, and the injustice being done canada in the eyes of our own people and in the eyes of the world, should be ended as speedily as possible. In those reasons and in the fact that already it is desirable to extend the scope of service under the National Resources Mobilization Act to other perts of this continent and adjacent islands, you will find, I believe, wherein the war situation has rendered necessary the introduction, without delay, of the proposed amendment to the National Resources Mobilization Act.
