
Zeiss Level No. IV with Stand.



Small level with new pattern telescope (fitted with Wild's inside focussing lens). The instrument is exceedingly rigid and will stand a considerable amount of hard use. The stand attaches to the level in a very simple manner, and the same applies to the accommodation of the instrument in its case.

The telescope magnifies 20 diameters and gives a very clearly defined and bright image. Staff divisions of $^{1}/_{2}$ inch can be read at a distance of 350 yards. The bubble casing and the telescope are made in one piece. A slow motion and clamp are provided for the rotation of the telescope about the vertical axis. The bubble is set with the aid of the tribrach screws. The instrument is adapted for practical levelling operations and, thanks to its exceedingly rigid design, is particularly well adapted for use as a ontractor's level.

The telescopes of all three levels have stadia diaphragms with a ratio constant of 1:100.
