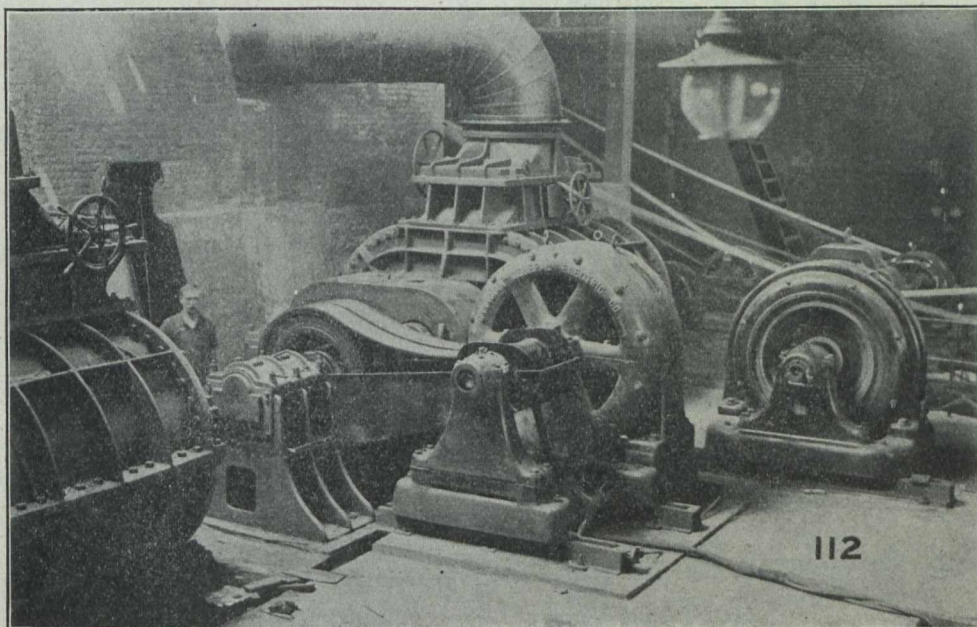


RENOLD PATENT SILENT CHAINS

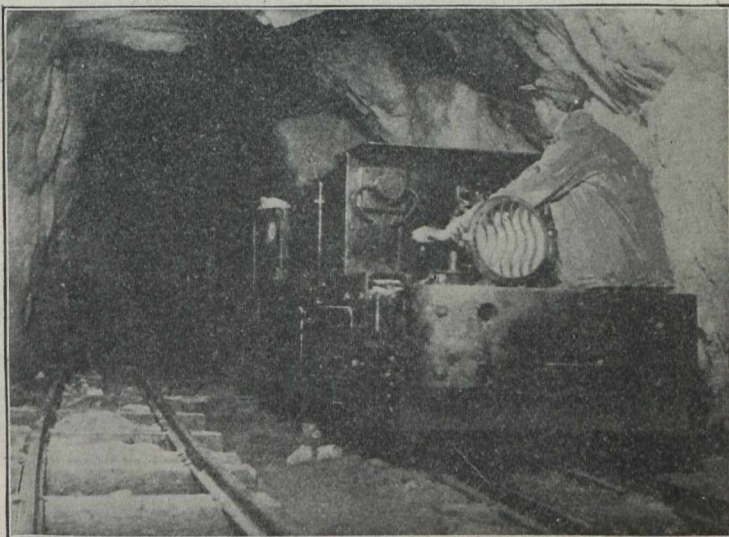
