 by the Grace of GOD of the United Kingdom of *Great-Britain and Ireland*,

An Act to continue for a limited time, the levying of the Duties imposed by the Act of the fifty-third year of His Majesty's Reign, chapter the eleventh, as amended by the Act of the fifty-fifth George the Third, chapter the second.

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,

Assemble. **W**HEREAS it is expedient and necessary for the prosperity of this Province, and for the support of Your Majesty's Government therein, to continue for a limited time, the levying of the Duties imposed by an Act passed in the fifty-third year
